Verulamium and Welwyn Baths

On 6th June 2017, Form III will be visiting Verulamium and Welwyn Baths.

As part of the History syllabus for Form III, I have arranged an educational visit to Verulamium Museum and Welwyn Roman Baths. They girls will be accompanied by Mrs Rushbrook, Mrs Balcombe and myself.

All girls must wear their blazers and bring their cagoules. A plastic bin bag or mat to use as a sitter would also be helpful. The girls will eat their lunch either in Verulamium Park or in the museum, depending on the weather.

During the morning the girls will be given a 'Hands on Session' for one hour, using Roman artefacts. Then, they will look round the museum, seeing at first hand the things they have been learning about Roman life in Britain.

In the afternoon we will visit the Roman bath house at Welwyn to learn how the Romans bathed and relaxed.

We will visit the Museum shop. Your daughter is encouraged to bring a maximum of £5 to spend, in a named, **wearable** purse.

The girls will be travelling by coach, leaving at 9:10 am and returning at approximately 2:30pm.

Each girl will need to bring a packed lunch with a drink (no glass bottles or nuts please), plus a cagoule, as they will be eating outside. Similarly, please ensure that your daughter has enough drink to last the day.

The cost of this visit will be £20.00, which will be debited to your daughter's account. If we do not hear from you to the contrary by 1st June 2017, we shall assume that you give permission for your daughter to attend this trip.

I am very much looking forward to this trip and hope that your daughter will enjoy the day.
