

A royal day out at Windsor Castle

On Friday, 15th March, Form VI will be undertaking a very special school trip to Windsor Castle.

We will be visiting The State Apartments including Queen Mary's Dolls House, and spending some time in St George's Chapel, where recent royal weddings have been held and where several of the more recent monarchs, together with Edward IV and Henry VIII, are buried. Throughout the day we will be self-directed, and will have audio guides to inform us in the State Apartments. The trip complements the two topics that we are studying in History this term and next, and from Form V.

The girls will be travelling by coach, leaving at 7.45am and returning at approximately 5.00pm. This is a long day, but as the travel includes the M25, it is necessary to leave early in order to reach Windsor in good time for the opening of the Castle at 10am.

Each girl will need to wear her blazer, bring her cagoule and enough water to last throughout the day. A packed lunch will be provided by the school kitchen and your daughter will have the opportunity to choose her sandwich filling beforehand. As it is a long day, it would be advisable to send in a snack to eat upon arrival, and another snack for the return journey.

The cost of this visit will be £25 which will be debited to your daughter's account. If we do not hear from you to the contrary by Friday 8th March we shall assume that you give permission for your daughter to attend this trip.

There is space for two or three parents who wish to attend this trip, so please can you let me know directly. This has proved a popular trip in the past so it will be strictly first come, first served.

I am very much looking forward to this trip to Her Majesty's home and hope that the girls will enjoy what promises to be a memorable trip.
