Nursery : Summer Term 2 2018

Dear Parents,

We hope that you have enjoyed a lovely half-term and are now looking forward to our final term in Nursery. The term is really busy and packed with lots of exciting activities and events.

This term our topic is 'Under the Sea'. Within this topic we will be learning about 'Fish', 'Sea Creatures' and sharing 'Favourite Seaside Stories'. Our role-play area will become a seaside shop, where the girls can role-play real life scenarios, dress up in summer clothes and shoes, purchase buckets and spades and share picnics and ice creams, (PSE, EAD and Maths).

We are looking forward to our summer show, commencing on Monday 2nd July 2018. The girls are already very good at singing the songs and we will shortly be learning a dance routine, which we know you are going to love, (PD and EAD). Mrs Lipman will be working with the girls on the show songs during their Music lessons this half-term.

We will also be practising for our very own Nursery Sports Day at the end of term, (PD). We will be inviting you to join us to cheer the Nursery girls on and enjoy tea and scones after the races.

We would also like to celebrate Father's Day, by inviting the Daddies or Grandads in for part of the morning to share some stories with us and join us in our play and learning, (PSE and Literacy).

Our swimming lessons in the St Hilda's pool will commence on Friday 8th June 2018, (PD). Thank you to all parents who have volunteered to join us in the pool. If the weather is poor and the session is cancelled, parent helpers will be notified via an email from the office.

On Tuesday 10th July we will be going on an outing with Reception to Bekonscot Model Village, Beaconsfield. More details to follow.

We will continue with our Tuesday 'Jolly Phonics' lessons, introducing the remaining single sounds and consolidating our previously learnt sounds. We will also be working in groups using 'Sound Talk' and where appropriate beginning to blend and segment simple words.

In our individual reading sessions, sharing 'core books', we will continue to look at features such as rhyme, the story setting, who the characters are, how the characters feel, making predictions, recalling the sequence of the text and recognition of sounds and blends, as appropriate for each girl, (Literacy and CL).

French continues with Mrs Bishop each Thursday and lessons will continue to be themed to support our topic work on 'Under the Sea'.

Afternoon sessions will continue to be offered on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons. Please note there will be **no afternoon sessions week commencing Monday 18th June** due to inductions for the new Nursery girls.

We will be holding an EYFS Celebration of Children's Work on Friday 6th July, where you will have the opportunity to see you daughter's Learning Journal and the lovely work on display in the classroom.
