Visit to Celtic Harmony

On Wednesday 16th September 2020, Form III and IV will be visiting Celtic Harmony.

As part of the History syllabus for Form III (and in the absence of the trip for the 'new' Form IV last year), I have arranged an educational visit to the Celtic Harmony Camp. Miss Humphris, Mrs Balcombe and I will be accompanying the girls.

During the day the girls will experience life in an Iron Age village, seeing how the Britons lived before the Roman invasion. They will see Celtic round houses, farming and crafts and take part in a variety of activities.

The girls will be travelling by coach, leaving at 9 am and returning at approximately 3:20pm.

Each girl will need to bring their cagoule and enough water to last throughout the day. A packed lunch will be provided by the school kitchen and your daughter will have the opportunity to choose her sandwich filling beforehand. Your daughter will need to wear her trainers, tracksuit bottoms and top from her PE kit. Girls should also have a sunhat.

As the weather is forecast to be hot, please can we ask that you apply sun cream to your daughter before she arrives. You can also put a small bottle for the girls, to reapply, if required.

We have been given Co-vid guidelines by both the coach company and Celtic Harmony, as to how the day should be carried out. The coach driver and adults will be required to wear a mask on the coach, the girls are not required although if you would be happier for them to do so, please provide one for your daughter. The girls will sanitise their hands, on entry and on departing the coach. At Celtic Harmony the activities will be outside, and the girls will be working in their own classes. We will make sure that hands are cleaned/sanitised regularly.

The cost of this visit will be £26.50 which will be debited to your daughter's account.

I am very much looking forward to this trip and hope that your daughter will enjoy the day. Thank you for your support in this trip.
