### Trip to Celtic Harmony

Dear Parents

On Friday 17th September 2021, Form III will be visiting Celtic Harmony as part of our History topic.

During our visit, the children will experience life as Stone Age hunter gatherers. They will learn about farming and crafts, take part in a variety of activities such as hunting practice, an exciting gathering game, cooking as well as some den building.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving at 9.00am and returning by 3.30pm. Children will need to bring their cagoule and water bottle. A packed lunch will be provided by the school kitchen. Children will need to wear their trainers, tracksuit bottoms and their top from their PE kit. I will send kit bags home on Thursday night.

Children can bring between £2- £5 pocket money to spend during their visit if they wish. They will have a unique opportunity to trade and role-play using real artefacts as farmers, hunters, miners etc. and exchange goods of different values using their numeracy skills. Children then swap their pocket money into reproduced Celtic coins, to choose a souvenir from the Trading Post.

The cost of this visit will be £37 which will be debited to your daughter's account.

It promises to be a great day and will hopefully bring our History topic to life!
