How to book:

Class information:

Classes run in the dedicated Art Studio. After school Art club begins at 4pm, attendees can be booked into school after school club until participants are collected. Participants are escorted down at the end of the 45 minute session for dismissal to parents or return to the ASC.

Full day Art Club has two breaks - timetable detailed on booking form.

If a class becomes full, a waiting list system will operate. You will be informed as soon as a place becomes available.
